An introductory social skills program for children aged 8 to 16

Led by licensed therapists, the Adventure Together program at the Casa Colina Children's Services Center is an introductory social skills program. Adventure Together gives participants access to diverse leisure activities that promote improved quality of life through social and community engagement. Program levels consist of ten weekly sessions that focus on:

- ◆ Personal space
- ◆ Sharing and turn-taking
- ◆ Basic conversation skills
- ◆ Engaging in group activities with peers
- ◆ Social greetings and farewells

All sessions take place at the Children's Services Center (Building 10) on our Pomona campus. Dates and times of all classes are subject to change. Please call the number below for more information.

- ◆ **Adventure Together I: 8 to 12 Years Old**
Thursday, 3:30 - 5:30 p.m.
- ◆ **Adventure Together II: 12 to 16 Years Old**
