KIDS CREW A social skills program for children aged 4 to 12

Led by licensed occupational therapists and speech-language pathologists and assistants, the Kids Crew program at the Casa Colina Children's Services Center is a social skills program designed for children ages 4 to 12 years old. All program levels consist of eight weekly sessions that focus on:

- Personal space
- Initiating play with peers
- Engaging in play with peers
- Responding to interactions
- Greetings/farewells
- Body language
- Reading social situations and cues

- Maintaining conversations
- On-topic comments
- Flexibility and expansion of play
- Sportsmanship
- Sharing and turn-taking
- Entering play spaces
- Self-advocacy

Our program is divided into three age levels. All sessions take place at the Children's Services Center (Building 10) on our Pomona campus, except where indicated. Dates and times of all classes are subject to change. Please call the number below for more information.
