Did you know?

- Studies show that some healthcare providers practice hand hygiene **less than half of the times they should.**
- Healthcare providers might need to clean their hands as many as **100 times per 12-hour shift!**

Clean Hands Count!



- Practice hand hygiene before and after every patient contact.
- Gloves are not a substitute for hand hygiene! Appropriate hand hygiene must take place before and after glove use.
- When caring for patients with C.difficile, always use gloves and always wash your hands with soap and water.
- When using alcohol-based hand sanitizer, your hands should stay wet for at least 20 seconds - if you used the right amount.

Casa Colina's Hand Hygiene Program

- Our facility-wide hand hygiene goal is 95%; however we'd love to reach 100%!
- For quarter 2, we are currently at 90.5% compliance.
- Perform appropriate hand hygiene to keep your patients, your family and yourself safe!
- Remind your colleagues of the importance of hand hygiene.

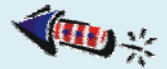
