Thank you for your interest in the Neurologic Residency Program at Casa Colina. The program will begin in late June for the didactic courses and late July/early August for clinical practice.

Curriculum

- 850 hours of clinical practice (17 hours per week)
- 150 hours of one to one mentoring (3 hours per week)
 - 16-week rotation in inpatient rehabilitation
 - 16-week rotation in transitional living center
 - 16-week rotation in outpatient neurology
 - 1-week in acute care (optional)
 - 1-week in pediatrics (optional)
- 240 hours of didactic/lab education
- 260 hours of resident directed learning opportunities (research, clinic, etc.)

The didactic/lab education is provided through the Neurologic Physical Therapy Professional Education Consortium (<http://pt2.usc.edu/neuroconsortium>). Two 4- day courses are required (August and November) in addition to webinar and journal club readings.
