CURRICULUM AND FACULTY

Thank you for your interest in the Neurologic Residency Program at Casa Colina. The program will begin July 29th for 50 weeks.

Curriculum

- 850 hours of clinical practice (17 hours per week)
- 150 hours of one to one mentoring (3 hours per week)
 - 16-week rotation in inpatient rehabilitation
 - 16-week rotation in transitional living center
 - 16-week rotation in outpatient neurology
 - 1-week in acute care
 - 1-week in pediatrics
- 500 hours of didactic/lab education and resident directed activities (maximum of 60% of hours may come from one category)

The content of the didactic/lab and clinical practice in this residency encompass the following areas:

- Neurological Differential Diagnosis
- Lower Extremity Orthotics
- Kinematic Tests and Measurements for Neurologic Disorders
- Vestibular Rehabilitation
- Principles and Practice of Assistive Technology
- Neuroplasticity and Motor Control
- Clinical Management of Neurodegenerative Disorders
- EMG and Nerve Conduction Studies in Clinical Practice
- Introduction to Dynamic Neuromuscular Stabilization Approach
