

TEEN SCENE

A social and life skills program for teens and young adults

Led by licensed occupational therapists and speech-language pathologists and assistants, the Teen Scene program at the Casa Colina Children's Services Center is a social and life skills program designed for teens and young adults between 13 and 22 years of age. Program levels consist of 12 weekly sessions that focus on:

- ◆ Entering and maintaining participation in social activities
- ◆ Body awareness and body language
- ◆ Functional communication
- ◆ Table manners and hygiene
- ◆ Personal space
- ◆ Problem solving and conflict resolution
- ◆ Cooperative planning
- ◆ Establishing and maintaining friendships
- ◆ Employment readiness
- ◆ Community outings

Our program is divided into two age-appropriate levels: 13-17 and 18-22 years old. **All groups meet at Casa Colina Hospital and Centers for Healthcare in Pomona, Building 5, unless otherwise noted.** Dates and times of all classes are subject to change.
