Casa Colina Centers of Rehabilitation, David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA, and the California Institute of Technology are collaborating on a study that allows individuals with paralysis to control a computer using thought alone. We are recruiting subjects with quadriplegia who can:

- Attend Casa Colina 3-5 times a week for at least one year*
- Breathe on their own (no ventilator)
- Live within one hour of Casa Colina (Transportation available at no cost)
- Have electrodes implanted surgically, and then removed after one year by a leading UCLA neurosurgeon.
