

# KIDS CREW

## A social skills program for children aged 4 to 12

Led by licensed occupational therapists and speech-language pathologists and assistants, the Kids Crew program at the Casa Colina Children's Services Center is a social skills program designed for children ages 4 to 12 years old. All program levels consist of eight weekly sessions that focus on:

- ◆ Personal space
- ◆ Initiating play with peers
- ◆ Engaging in play with peers
- ◆ Responding to interactions
- ◆ Greetings/farewells
- ◆ Body language and eye contact
- ◆ Maintaining conversations
- ◆ On-topic comments
- ◆ Flexibility of play
- ◆ Sportsmanship
- ◆ Sharing and turn-taking
- ◆ Entering play space

Our program is divided into three age levels. All sessions take place at the Children's Services Center on our Pomona campus, except where indicated:

- ◆ **4 to 6 Years Old:** Tuesdays 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.
- ◆ **6 to 8 Years Old:** Thursdays 1:30 to 3:30 p.m.
- ◆ **9 to 12 Years Old:** Tuesdays 3:30 to 5:30 p.m.;  
Wednesdays 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. (online);  
Thursdays 4:00 to 6:00 p.m.
