KIDS CREW

A social skills program for children aged 4 to 12

Led by licensed occupational therapists and speech-language pathologists and assistants, the Kids Crew program at the Casa Colina Children's Services Center is a social skills program designed for children ages 4 to 12 years old. All program levels consist of eight weekly sessions that focus on:

- Personal space
- Initiating play with peers
- Engaging in play with peers
- Responding to interactions
- Greetings/farewells
- Body language and eye contact

- Maintaining conversations
- On-topic comments
- Flexibility of play
- Sportsmanship
- Sharing and turn-taking
- Entering play space

Our program is divided into three age levels. All sessions take place at the Children's Services Center on our Pomona campus, except where indicated:

- 4 to 6 Years Old: Tuesdays 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.
- 6 to 8 Years Old: Thursdays 1:30 to 3:30 p.m.
- 9 to 12 Years Old: Tuesdays 3:30 to 5:30 p.m.; Wednesdays 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. (online); Thursdays 4:00 to 6:00 p.m.
