Led by licensed therapists, the Early Adventure Program at the Casa Colina Children's Services Center is an introductory social connection program for children with autism and other social communication disabilities. Early Adventure gives participants access to age-appropriate activities that help them make improvements in social connection, play skills, and peer interactions.

Groups are small (usually 3-5 children) and are led by two licensed therapists specializing in speech-language pathology and/or occupational therapy.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

The program consists of one-hour weekly sessions focused on:

- Sharing and turn-taking
- Basic conversation skills
- Engaging in group activities with peers
- Self-advocacy

This program accepts a variety of funding sources, including most medical insurances, school districts, self-determination programs, or cash pay.
