Bridge Builders is made for children and adolescents with neuro-based diagnoses with medical involvement (for example, cerebral palsy, TBI, genetic syndromes, etc.). We offer a variety of social connection groups at Casa Colina, which each focus on different goals through their own activities/curriculum. Therapists will evaluate which group may be the best fit for your child!

This group aims to accommodate children with additional needs, but all participants will need to safely move around (e.g. wheelchair, crutches, walking, etc.) and participate in group activities. We require an absence of aggression (towards self or others), unsafe behaviors, and self-stimulatory behaviors that inhibit group interactions.
