
# SPINAL CORD INJURY PROGRAM OUTCOMES



### Patients with a Spinal Cord Injury receive high quality medical and rehabilitation services, allowing them to return home, and stay home, after discharge.


### 78%% of inpatients returned to the community at discharge





### 96% of inpatients remained in the community 3 months after discharge


Spinal Cord Injury: Remain in Community at 3 months






### Casa Colina provides an average of 133 minutes of therapy per day; 94% individual minutes for persons with Spinal Cord Injury






#### SCI: Total Therapy Minutes Per Day

### Acute Rehabilitation Unit- Spinal Cord Injury Patient Outcomes 2024

Over 91% of patients receive continued therapy after discharge

Patients with a brain injury were satisfied or highly satisfied with these aspects of care:	2024
