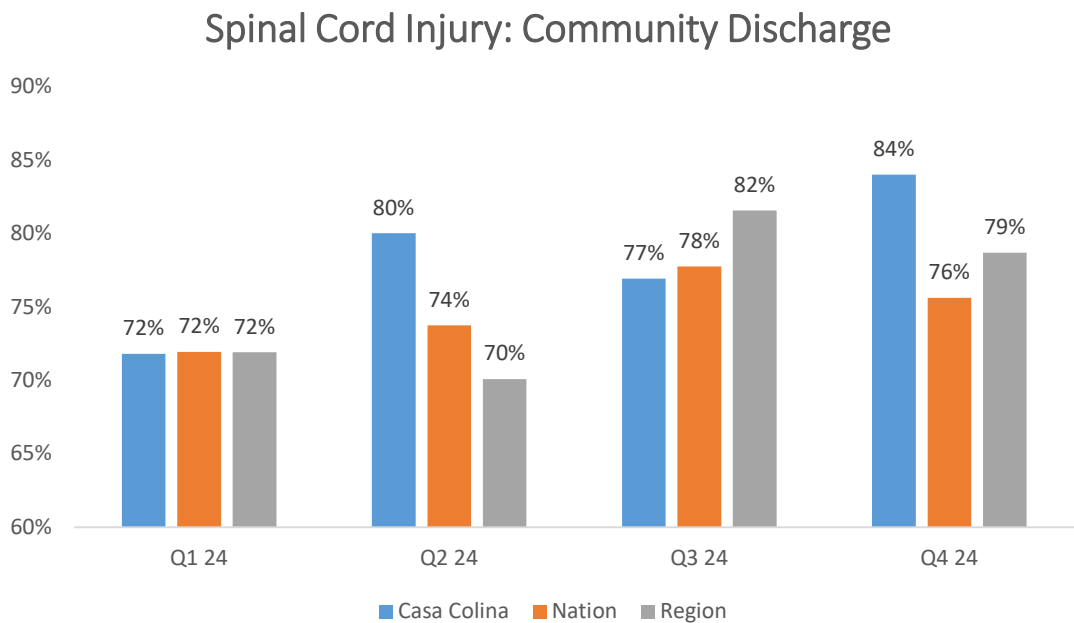


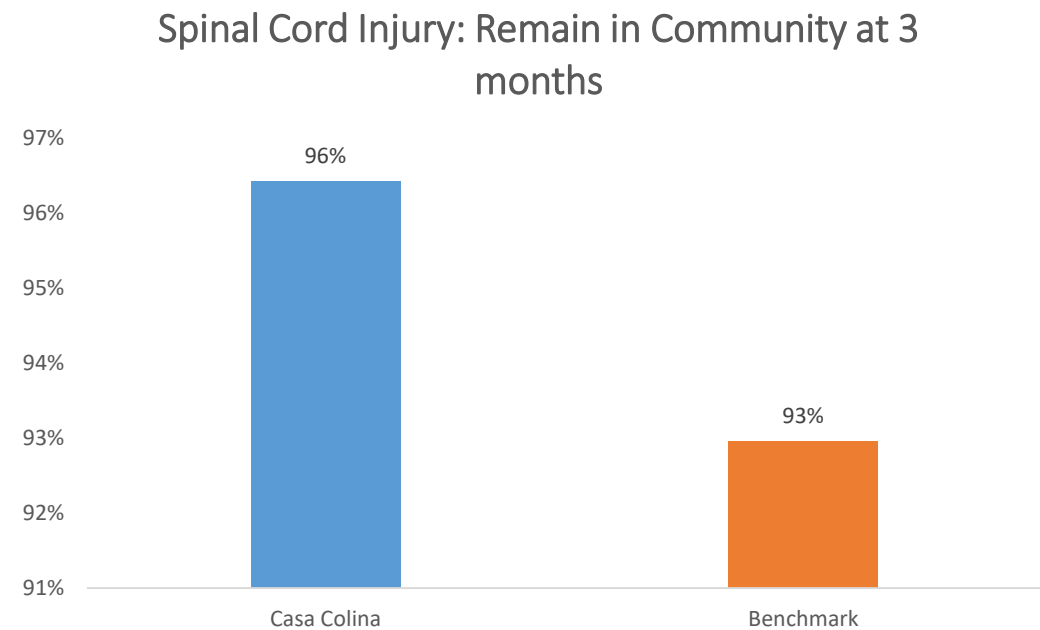
SPINAL CORD INJURY PROGRAM OUTCOMES

Patients with a Spinal Cord Injury receive high quality medical and rehabilitation services, allowing them to return home, and stay home, after discharge.

78%% of inpatients returned to the community at discharge

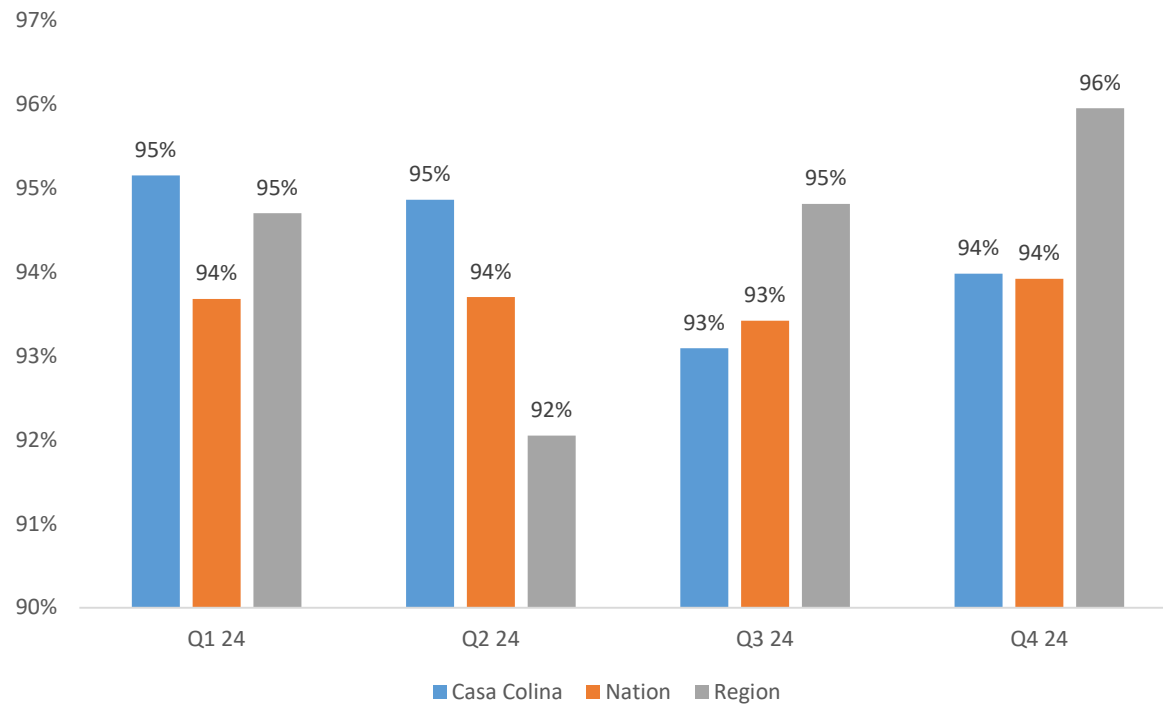


96% of inpatients remained in the community 3 months after discharge

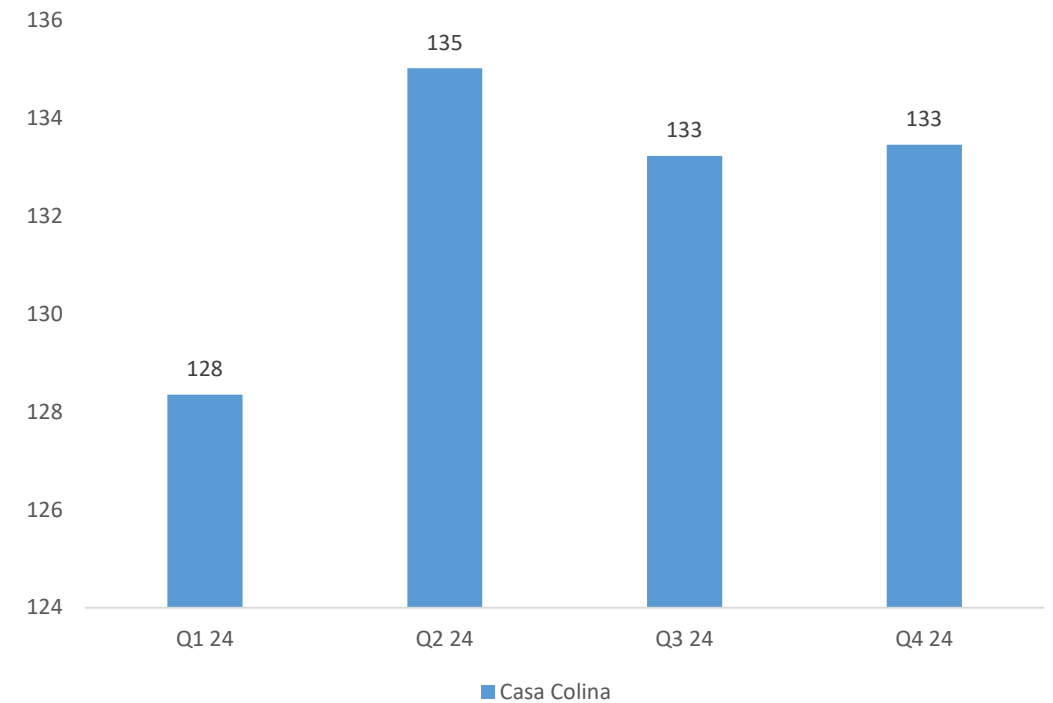


Casa Colina provides an average of 133 minutes of therapy per day; 94% individual minutes for persons with Spinal Cord Injury

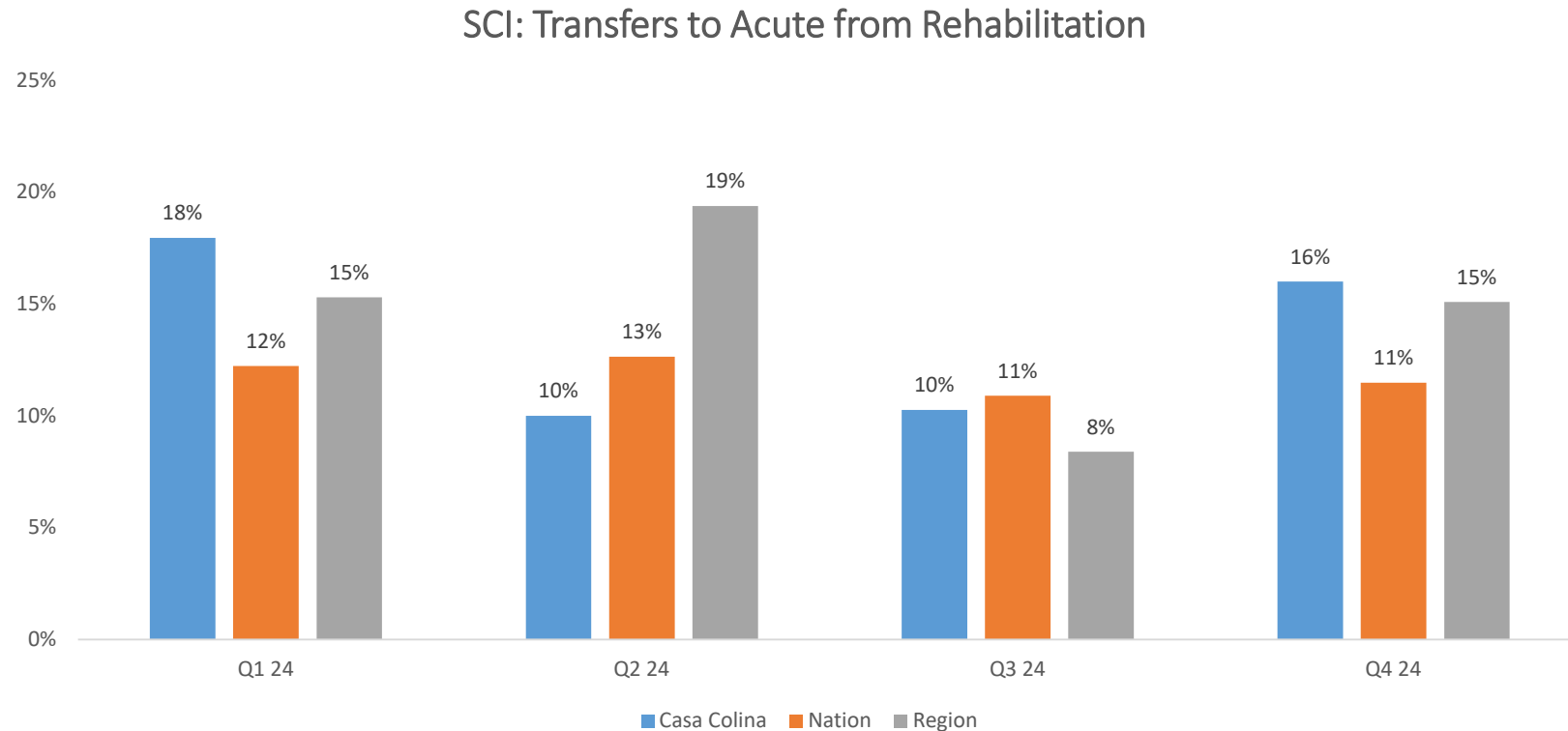
SCI: Individual Therapy Minutes Per Day

Casa Colina transfers 14% of patients with Spinal Cord Injury out for acute medical care; similar to other programs in the nation.

Acute Rehabilitation Unit- Spinal Cord Injury Patient Outcomes 2024 (3 months post discharge)

Over 91% of patients receive continued therapy after discharge

Patients with a brain injury were satisfied or highly satisfied with these aspects of care:	2024
