

Research Study: Mobility Scooter Safety Study

What is the purpose of this study?

We aim to enhance the safety and usability of motorized mobility scooters. Your participation will help us gather data to achieve these goals and publish our findings.



What is involved with participation?

- You will be asked to drive a motorized scooter and complete a series of 29 tasks around the campus.
- Tasks include maneuvers such as moving forwards, backwards, turning in place, navigating inclines, and operating various scooter functions.

Who is eligible to participate?

- Be at least 18 years old with an impairment in your lower extremities.
- Have the ability to follow instructions in English.
- Must be capable of operating a motorized mobility scooter.
- Willingness to complete the assigned tasks and adhere to safety protocols.
- Must be able to sit independently without experiencing pain for up to 1 hour.
