

ARE YOU INTERESTED IN CONTROLLING A COMPUTER USING THOUGHT?

Are you quadriplegic who would like to advance science and technology?

Casa Colina Hospital and Centers for Healthcare, David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA, and the California Institute of Technology are collaborating on a study that enables individuals with paralysis to control a computer using thought alone. We are recruiting subjects with quadriplegia who can:

- ✓ Attend Casa Colina 3-5 times a week for at least one year*
- ✓ Live within one hour of Casa Colina (transportation available at no cost)
- ✓ Have electrodes implanted surgically, and then removed after one year by a leading UCLA neurosurgeon

* Study sessions will last 3-4 hours. During this time, you will learn to control the computer interface with the aide of the study team.
