Attention: Visitors to Our Inpatient Rehabilitation Wing

Although Covid-19 risk factors are not as severe as they once were for many, our inpatient rehabilitation patients are vulnerable to current variants, and their safety is our highest priority.

To maximize their safety, Casa Colina has established the following requirements for visitation to our Inpatient Rehabilitation Wing:

- As mandated by the California and Los Angeles County Departments of Public Health, visitors must wear a mask covering the nose and mouth at all times, even when visiting outside.
- Visitors may not eat while visiting patients, even if outside. If you must consume a snack or beverage while visiting, please do so outside the facility.
- Please wash your hands before and after meeting with loved ones. Hand sanitizer dispensers are widely available within all Casa Colina facilities.
- If you are visiting a patient in isolation, please wear the required personal protective equipment. Contact your patient's Casa Colina nurse if you are unsure what to wear.
- Patients may have only 2 visitors at a time, even when visiting outside.
- Please maintain social distancing of 6 feet.
- Visitors who fail to comply with mask regulations will be asked to leave.

Visiting hours are 10 a.m. - 1 p.m. and 5 - 8 p.m., Monday through Friday; 10 a.m. - 8 p.m., Saturday and Sunday. No advanced scheduling is required. Visitors must be 14 or older for indoor visitation.
